Attachment B: U.S. Government Contract Requirements

1. Arnold Defense & Electronics, LLC (“ADE”) is a supplier to the U.S. Government. Seller understands that its supplies/services may be used in support of one or more of ADE’s U.S. Government contracts and, therefore, Seller is also subject to requirements of the U.S. Government as set forth in this Attachment.
2. The clauses listed below in Paragraph 6, “Incorporated Clauses,” are included in one or more of ADE’s contracts with the U.S. Government and are incorporated into the Purchase Order by reference. Those clauses incorporated by reference apply to the Seller with the same force and effect as if incorporated in full text.
3. The clauses are passed through to the Seller in the same form as in ADE’s contracts with the U.S. Government, except that:
 - (i) “NAVSEA” or “the Government” mean “ADE”;
 - (ii) “Contractor” and “Subcontractor” mean “Seller”;
 - (iii) Any reference to a time period for compliance with reporting/notifications is adjusted by decreasing the response time by 10 calendar days to allow ADE adequate time to comply at the higher tier.
4. The version of each clause applicable to this Purchase Order is the version of the clause included in ADE’s contracts with the U.S. Government. Seller can access the full text of these clauses on the Internet at the following address: <https://www.acquisition.gov>. If a clause is not available at the referenced address and Seller would like a copy of the clause, Seller shall promptly request the clause from ADE.
5. The following circumstances are exceptions to the flow-down requirements above, and the general rules of construction for flow-down clauses set forth above:
 - (i) Where it is clear, by the context of the provision itself or the conditions under which it is being applied, that the reference is intended to refer to the U.S. Government, its officers, or agents, or ADE specifically; or
 - (ii) Where interpretation in accordance with the rules stated above would place ADE in a position of violating the equivalent or related provisions of its contracts with the U.S. Government whereas construction of the terms without modification would not.
